Title: Exploring Argumentation Paradigms in HPE Validity.

Brief Description:
Many in HPE hold that validity is a form of argument made in support of educational decisions. Current validity frameworks (e.g. Messick and Kane) often cited in HPE provide an organization structure for evidence, but do not provide robust description of a paradigm for argumentation. This leaves us with questions such as: Which type of evidence is acceptable or most important for validity arguments? How should validity arguments be evaluated? By whom? How should validity arguments be structured? How can validity argumentation take place without knowing the rules of engagement, particularly when engagement depends on a shared understanding of the nature of argumentation? This would be akin to holding a courtroom trial while only knowing how to organize the evidence, but not knowing the rules of arguing the case, who the other arguers are, who will evaluate the argument, or how they will evaluate it. In this session, we will review different argumentation paradigms and explore which might help inform HPE validity work.

Ben is an associate professor of Internal Medicine and Pediatrics in the Division of Hospital Medicine at University of Cincinnati Medical Center and Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center where he is Associate Program Director for the Med-Peds and Internal Medicine residency programs. In 2020, Ben was selected for the Macy Faculty Scholars Program, and he is currently a PhD student at Maastricht University's School of Health Professions Education.

Title: Measurement Validity at the Nexus of Data Science, Digital Innovation, and a Social Justice Imperative: Embracing The Many Ways Of Being Human

Brief Description:
In the 21st century, questionnaires, surveys, and testing are instantiations of measurement opportunities that are the products of over 150 years of critical developments in fields as diverse as education, mathematics, psychology, philosophy, and statistical and computational sciences. Influenced by technological advances, we face a new world of digital innovation that brings a moral and ethical social justice imperative of the consequences of measurement opportunities used for planning interventions, decision-making, ranking, and policy purposes in the educational and social and health sciences. This imperative is framed by embracing the many ways of being human.
This address describes elements of an emerging paradigm that embodies an ecological model of item performance and scale/test scores supporting scale/test score validation as a form of abductive reasoning. In so doing, we identify clues about how a measurement opportunity is constructed, understood, and performed as a social occasion by observing the ecology of assessment.

Bruno D. Zumbo, Ph.D., is Professor and Distinguished University Scholar, Tier 1 Canada Research Chair in Psychometrics and Measurement, and the Paragon UBC Professor of Psychometrics & Measurement at the University of British Columbia. He is a mathematical scientist working at the intersection of the behavioural, social and health sciences. As an internationally recognized psychometrician and measurement theorist, his research program has influenced psychometric and validity theories, measurement invariance (DIF & test bias), and the quantification of error of measurement and reliability. His validity theory and measurement invariance insights have been twice recognized as a Killam Laureate (Research & Teaching awards) and the Samuel Messick Award.
